**NOTE:** Filipino World War II Veterans Parole Program applications are filed with the Lockbox and sent to a USCIS service center for conditional approval or denial. If conditionally approved, the case is forwarded abroad via the Department of State National Visa Center for beneficiary interview. The beneficiary also completes a medical examination and undergoes additional security screening abroad. (After completion of these steps, USCIS and DOS will either issue travel documents for the beneficiary to travel to the United States, or USCIS
