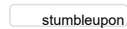


ADOPTION

Above said agencies registered their Representative offices at the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

The Representative offices obtained certificates of registration.

The Certificates authorize them to operate in said area according to their constituent documents within limits of the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Passport renewal

Citizens of the Republic of Kazakhstan need to supply the following papers in 3 copies to get a passport of the Republic of Kazakhstan or to renew the current one:

1. Application letter to the Consular Section of the Embassy of the Republic of Kazakhstan for a new/ or renewal of a passport
 2. Filled out copy of an Application Form for a new passport (applicant should sign inside the special box)
 3. Confirmation of correct spelling of family name, name and middle name
 4. Confirmation of correct spelling of parent's family name, name and middle name
 5. 4 photos of 3,5x4,5 cm size (colored pictures with white background, no hats, scarfs, sunglasses, e.t.c. are allowed) face should occupy no less than 70% of the picture
 6. Copy of a Birth Certificate of an applicant
 7. Copy of Marriage/Divorce Certificate
 8. Money Order for 50 dollars.
 9. In case of a passport loss (theft) the Police Report should be supplied. The additional payment for the loss of passport is 100 dollars.
- All documents issued by foreign (including US) authorities should be apostilled and translated on Kazakh or Russian languages.
10. Prepaid return USPS/UPS envelope if applicant wish to receive documents by mail. In case of using other post company applicant should negotiate with the company the pick up service from the Embassy.
- Embassy is not responsible for any loss of documents by mail service.
It takes approximately 5-6 months to get a new/renew passport.
