USCIS Sending Text and Email Messages About Online Filing

We are sending text and email messages between Sept. 17 and Sept. 20, 2018, about filing <u>Form I-90</u>, <u>Application to Replace Permanent Resident Card</u> online. If you are a lawful permanent resident and your Green Card has expired or is about to expire, or if you need to replace it for another reason, you may file Form I-90 online. Go to the <u>Form I-90 page</u> on our website to begin your online application process.

If you are a conditional permanent resident whose Green Card is about to expire, do not submit Form I-90. Instead, use <u>Form I-751</u>, <u>Petition to Remove Conditions on Residence</u> or <u>Form I-829</u>, <u>Petition by</u> <u>Entrepreneur to Remove Conditions</u>.

Remember: You should only use websites ending in .gov for official information from USCIS. While we use the GovDelivery.com service to send email messages, our text and email messages will include a link that takes you directly to the USCIS website and the link will always end in .gov. We never ask for any personal information in these messages.
