Reporting Volunteer Positions During OPT Employment

A volunteer position that is not directly related to an F-1 student's <u>course of study</u> does not qualify as <u>optional practical training (OPT)</u> and must not be listed as <u>OPT employment</u> on a student's Student and Exchange Visitor Information System record.

If you report a non-qualifying volunteer position as OPT employment, you are <u>violating your reporting</u> requirements and are subject to removal from the United States.

Additionally, it is important to remember that:

- You should not report a non-qualifying volunteer position as OPT employment in the <u>SEVP Portal</u>.
- Non-qualifying positions do not stop the accrual of unemployment, which is limited to a total of 90 days during OPT.
- If you have been unemployed for more than 90 days, you must leave the United States or be subject to removal, even if you have volunteered while unemployed.

As a note, volunteer positions do not meet the conditions of a science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) OPT extension. If you are completing a <u>24-month STEM OPT extension</u>, you must receive <u>compensation for your training opportunity</u>.
